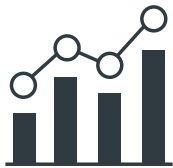

DATA SCIENCE

Accelerating success and ensuring students are prepared with the skills today's global economy demands, requires access to reliable, usable and actionable data. We obtain, process, link and analyze millions of records across K-12, higher education institutions, the workforce and other databases. This allows us to bring disparate data sets together, identify meaningful metrics and highlight important patterns and trends. Using this information, we develop comprehensive visualizations and tools that provide leaders with valuable insights needed to make data-informed decisions.

PREDICTIVE ANALYTICS

Organizations can plan for success when they know what works best. We use predictive analytics to identify the most successful K-12 and higher education systems and outcomes, isolate best practices, determine relationships between actions and outcomes, and issue productive recommendations. For example, we work with community colleges to implement multiple measures and leverage predictive analytics to place more incoming community college students in appropriate college-level courses - accelerating student success and removing barriers to degree completion.

DATA MANAGEMENT

Linking disparate data sources into one Kindergarten through career database helps guide data-informed conversations that drive positive change. We partner in managing Cal-PASS Plus - California's free longitudinal, intersegmental K-16 student data system. It includes student achievement, course taking, demographic and degree/transfer attainment data from California's K-12 schools, colleges and universities, as well as insights on transitions from education to the workforce. We manage the system and data sharing agreements, so that any Cal-PASS Plus member institution, including early childhood organizations, can utilize the data to understand and improve student performance and success across the education pipeline.

RESEARCH AND ANALYSIS

Using data in meaningful and actionable ways starts by knowing what to measure and how to measure it. We help organizations identify key issues, develop research questions and establish goals. We analyze the most critical information and data trends to find out what is going on and what is driving specific outcomes. Our research team works closely with K-12, higher education institutions, workforce agencies, early childhood, and other organizations to identify strategies for turning data into solutions.

OUR GROWING IMPACT

Our longitudinal database on student achievement and employment is the largest in the nation and still growing, with data from all 50 states.

We have strong relationships with like-minded organizations and are actively conducting work in California, Texas, Oregon and North Carolina.
